**3. BRIANE SIMPSON**

- As of September 10, 2020, 106 development permits have been issued valuing at approximately \$7 million for the 2020 year.
- The new pathways in town have received a lot of positive response.
- Crosswalks are being put in at all the high vehicle traffic areas where the paths intersect, HWY 845, Cottonwood, etc.
- Temporary direction signs, directing people to the various amenities in Coaldale, will be up and the Town will want feedback from the community on which one they would like.
- At our most recent Council meeting, a presentation was made regarding the Town Plan. There were a number of groups the Town needed to coordinate with, groups such as SMRID. The Town has obtained approval and have been given the green light to proceed. Council voted in favour of the plan. - The council driven municipal inspection was declined.
- Council made a motion to hire a third party HR investigator. This investigator will be hired from council with no administration involvement and they will talk to previous as well as present employees during their investigation. Council has taken this accusation seriously and want to ensure a safe workplace.
- A request was made to council regarding imposing a Mask Bylaw in Coaldale. We would like to here your thoughts.
- A number of corporations have already mandated PPE requirements to their branches.
- Question was raised as to the enforceability of such bylaw. Appears that the loopholes make the whole bylaw redundant.
